SUMMARY

Afghanistan ranks 137 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 32%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 34% and a data openness subscore of 30%.

Afghanistan scores higher than the regional median for social statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in economic and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and nonproprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
