## SUMMARY

Angola ranks 163 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 21%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 18% and a data openness subscore of 23%.

Angola scores higher than the regional median for social and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

### Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

### Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.

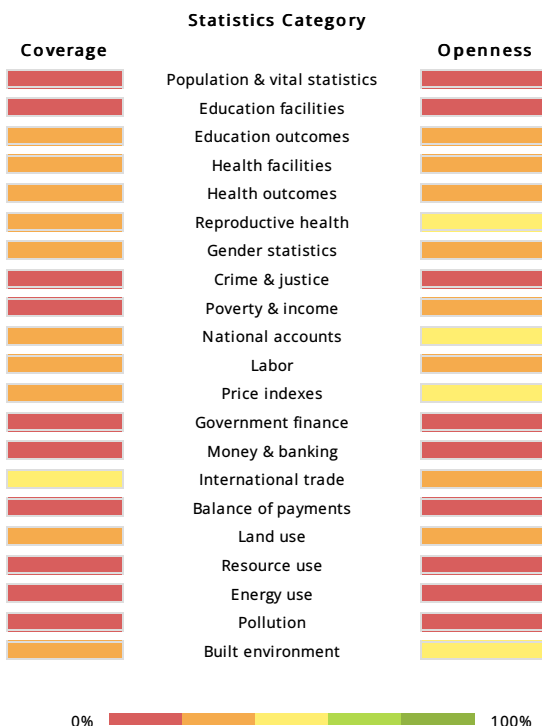
