SUMMARY

United Arab Emirates ranks 50 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 51%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 37% and a data openness subscore of 65%.

United Arab Emirates scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a noncommercial provision, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.

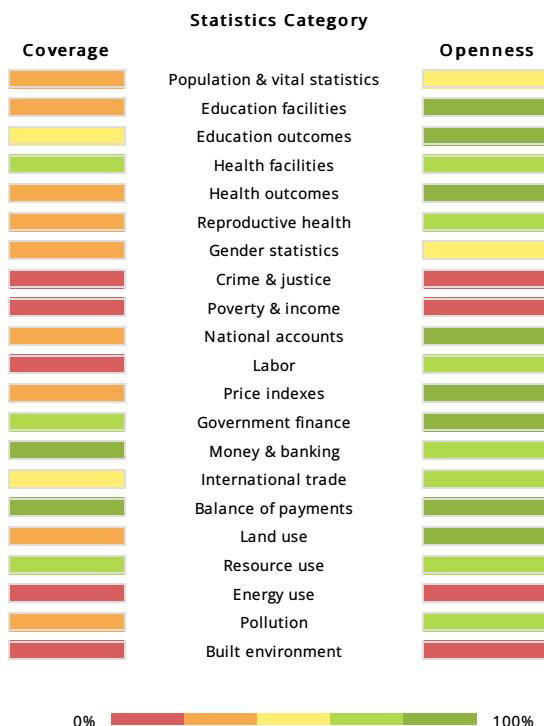
