SUMMARY

Austria ranks 35 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 56%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 52% and a data openness subscore of 61%.

Austria scores higher than the regional median for social statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
