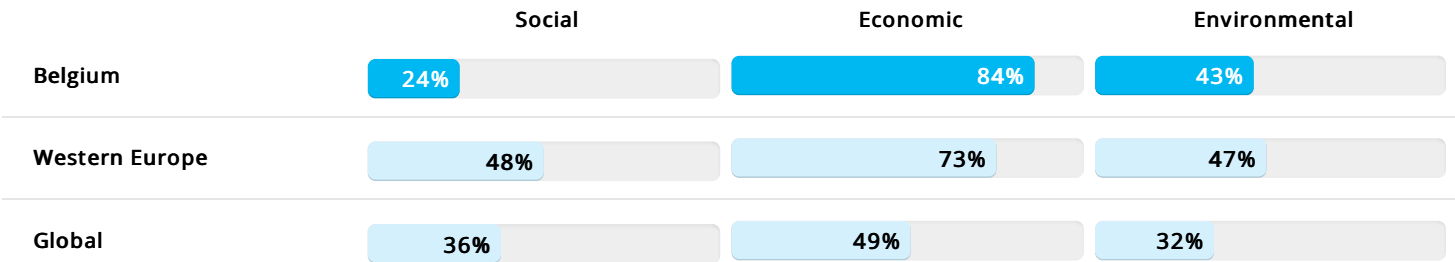

SUMMARY

Belgium ranks 56 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 49%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 45% and a data openness subscore of 53%.

Belgium scores higher than the regional median for economic statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

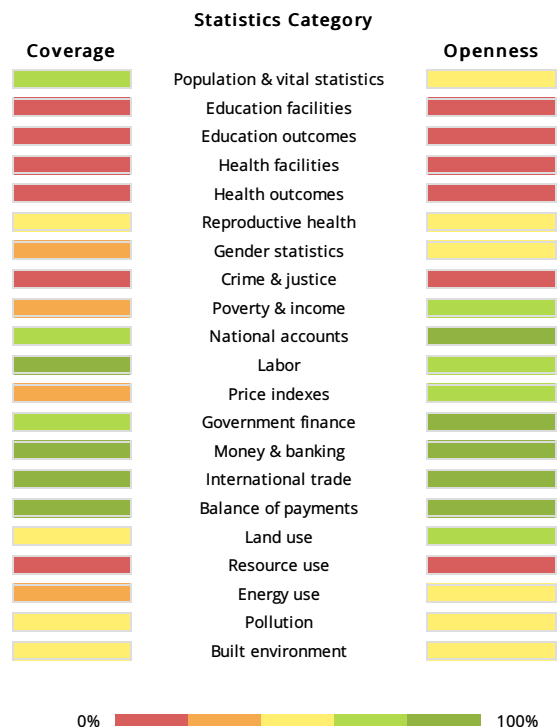
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a misleading clause, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more social data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
