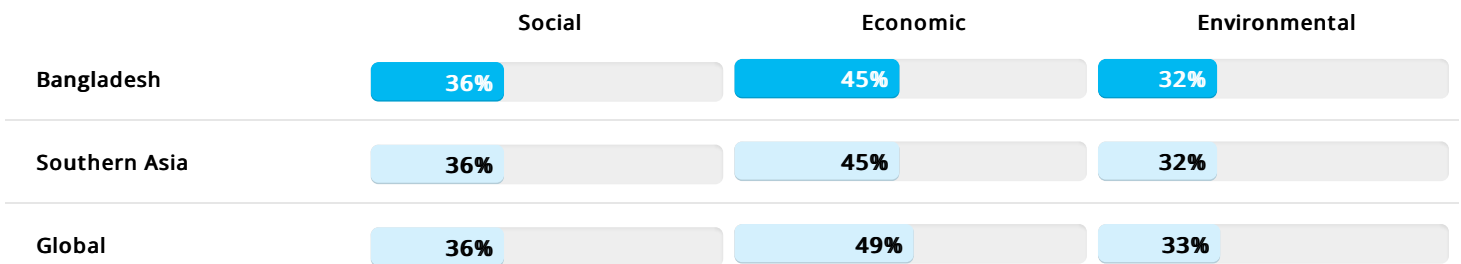

## SUMMARY

Bangladesh ranks 96 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 37%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 39% and a data openness subscore of 36%.

Bangladesh scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

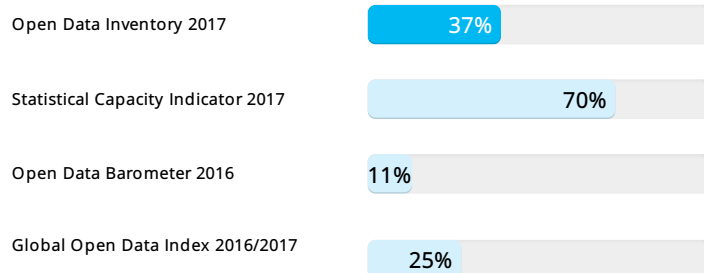
### Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data across all data categories.

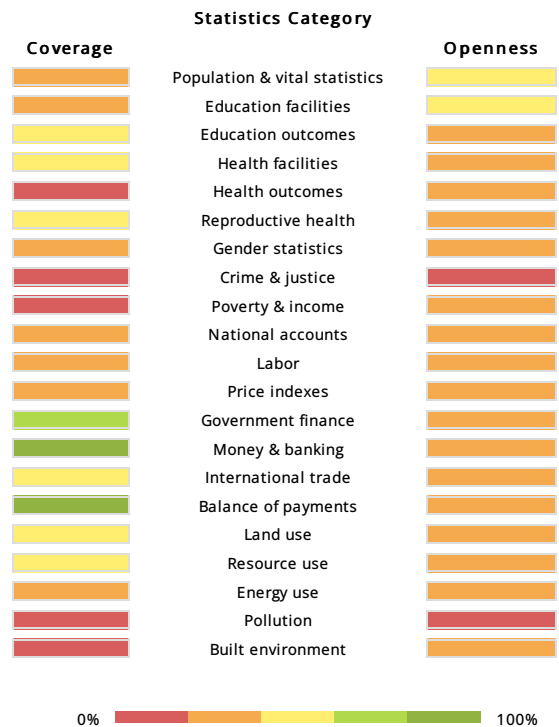
### Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a noncommercial provision, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
