SUMMARY

Bosnia and Herzegovina ranks 105 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 35%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 39% and a data openness subscore of 32%.

Bosnia and Herzegovina scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.


Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.


Openness
