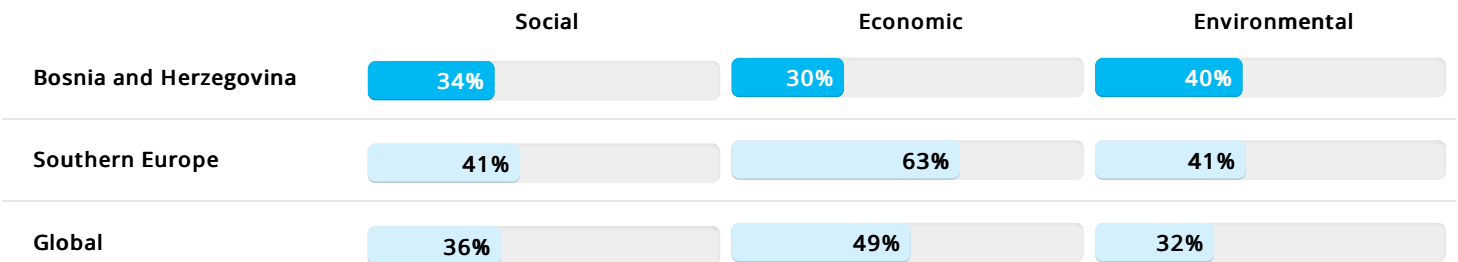

### SUMMARY

Bosnia and Herzegovina ranks 109 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 35%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 36% and a data openness subscore of 33%.

Bosnia and Herzegovina scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on economic statistics.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

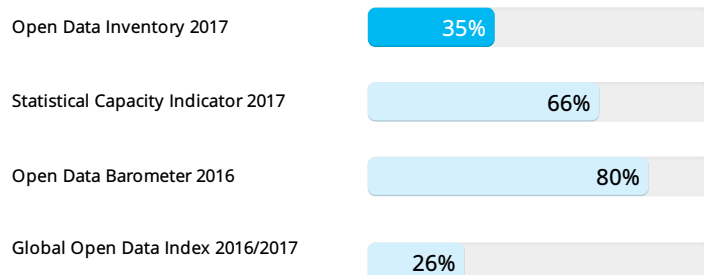
#### Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in economic statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

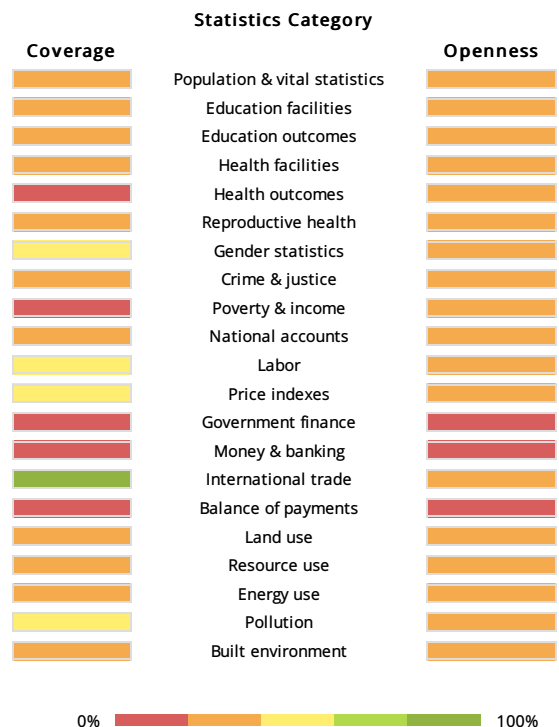
#### Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
