SUMMARY

Belarus ranks 48 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 50%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 65% and a data openness subscore of 37%.

Belarus scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

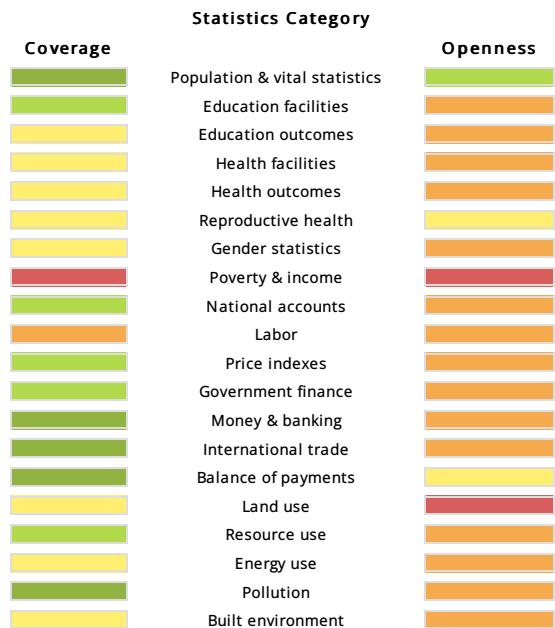
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first and second administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more data in machine readable formats such as XLSX, CSV or JSON.
