SUMMARY

Belarus ranks 65 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 51%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 66% and a data openness subscore of 38%.

Belarus scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
