SUMMARY

Canada ranks 8 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 77%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 68% and a data openness subscore of 85%.

Canada scores higher than the regional median for economic statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

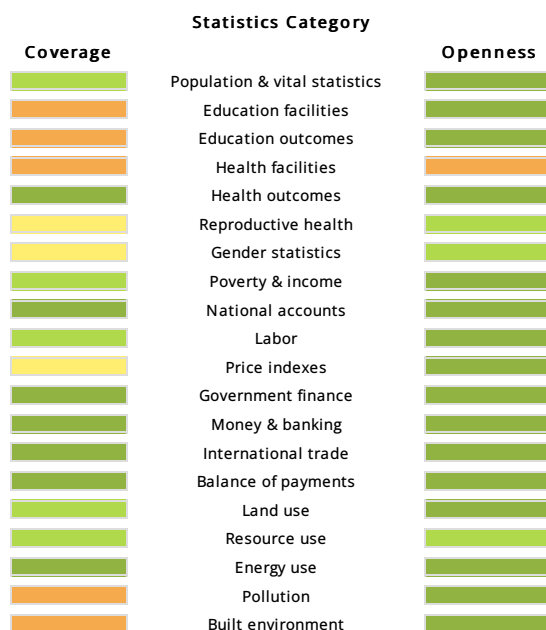
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Make available download options for all data to allow users to customize data exports.
