SUMMARY

Switzerland ranks 25 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 61%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 62% and a data openness subscore of 60%.

Switzerland scores higher than the regional median for social and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more historical data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more social and economic data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
