## SUMMARY

Switzerland ranks 49 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 52%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 46% and a data openness subscore of 58%.

Switzerland scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

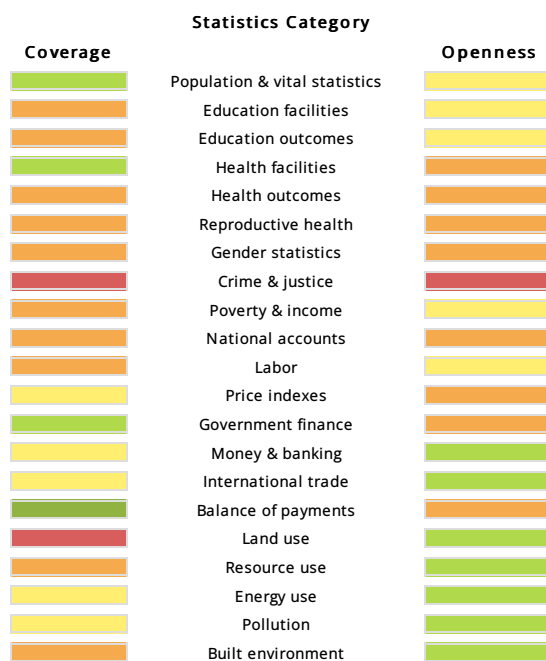
## Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

## Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use policy that does not require prior permission for data use.
- Publish more social and economic data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
