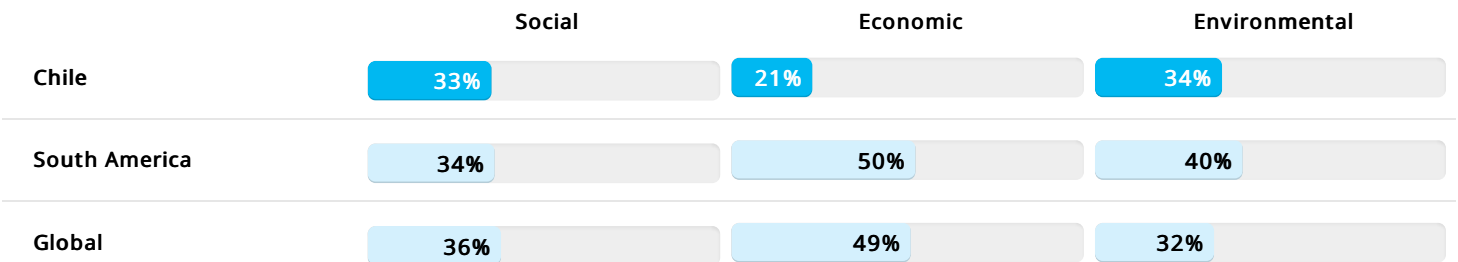

## SUMMARY

Chile ranks 130 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 30%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 35% and a data openness subscore of 24%.

Chile scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on economic statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

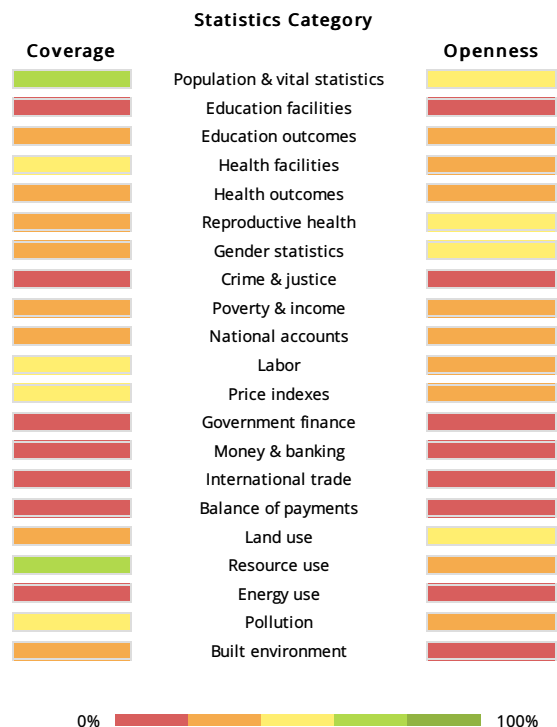
### Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

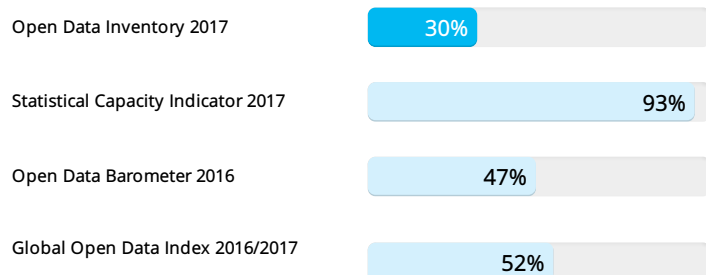
### Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a noncommercial provision, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more economic and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
