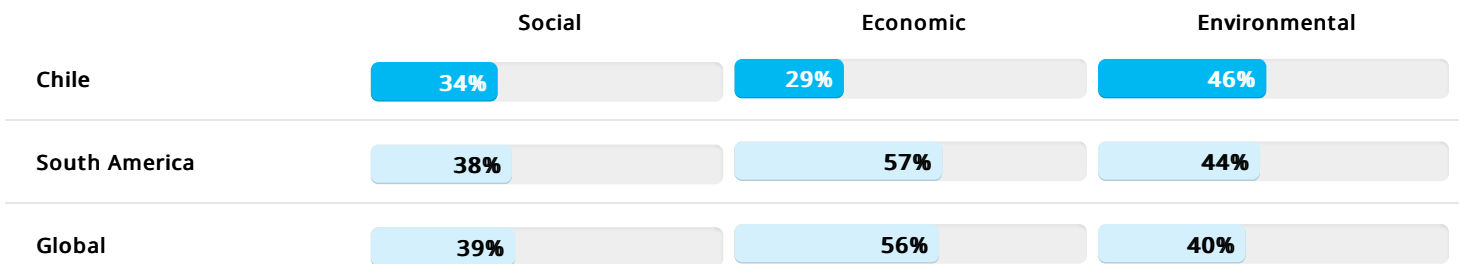

## SUMMARY

Chile ranks 120 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 36%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 42% and a data openness subscore of 31%.

Chile scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on economic statistics.

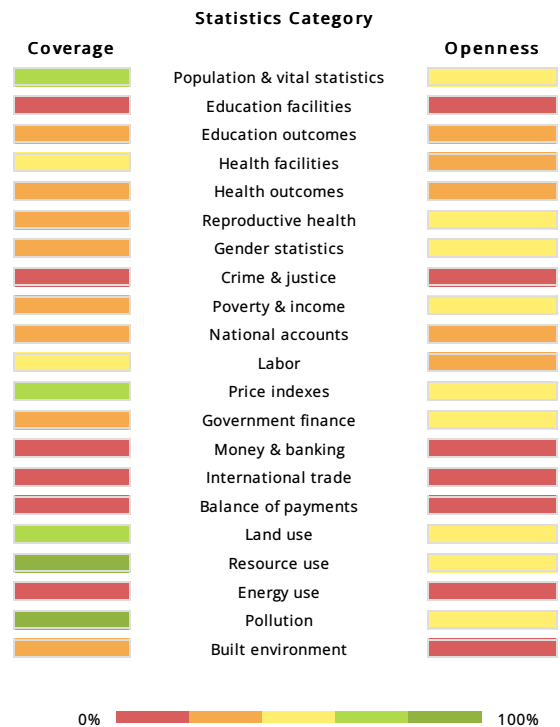
## Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and economic statistics.

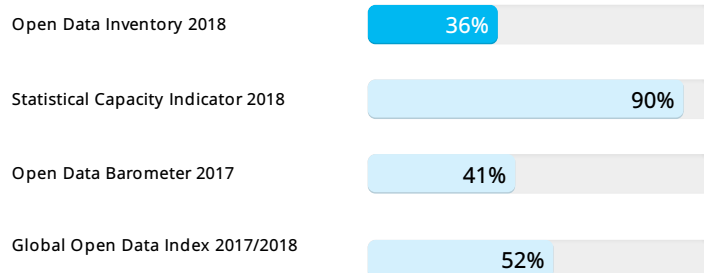
## Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
