SUMMARY

Colombia ranks 44 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 54%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 55% and a data openness subscore of 53%.

Colombia scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.

Openness


- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
