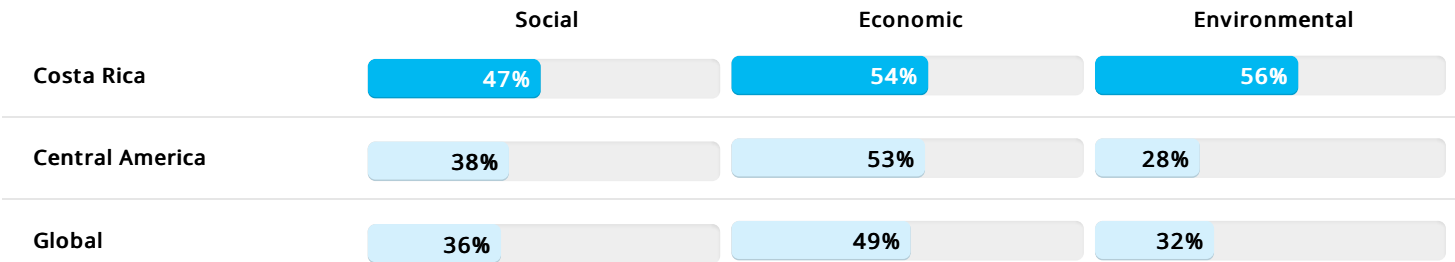

SUMMARY

Costa Rica ranks 47 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 52%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 44% and a data openness subscore of 60%.

Costa Rica scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

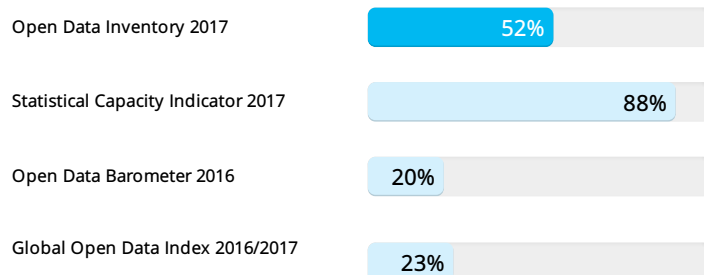
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data across all data categories.

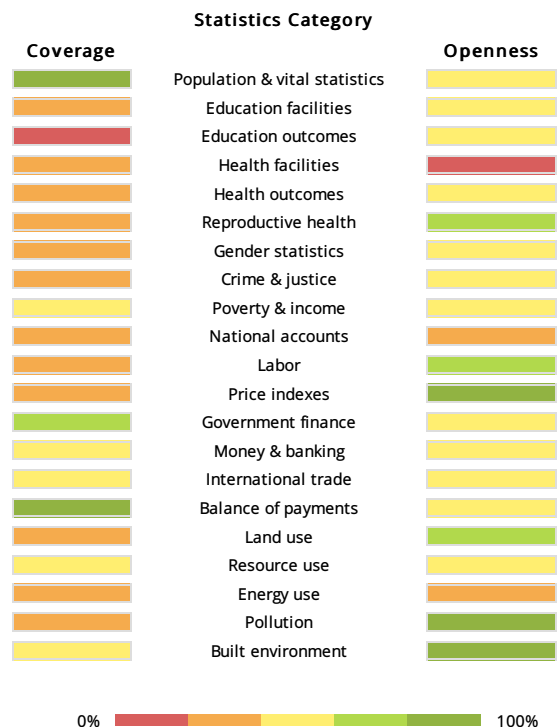
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more economic data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
