

SUMMARY

Cuba ranks 118 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 37%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 44% and a data openness subscore of 31%.

Cuba scores higher than the regional median for social and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and economic statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
