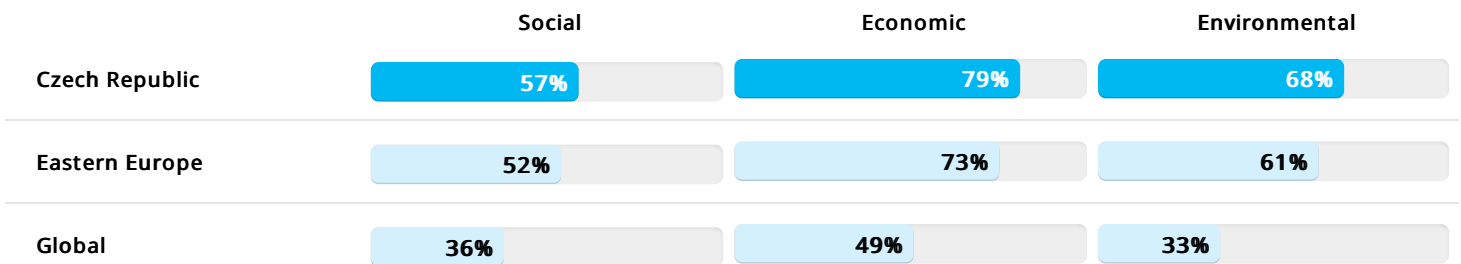

SUMMARY

Czech Republic ranks 16 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 68%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 64% and a data openness subscore of 70%.

Czech Republic scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

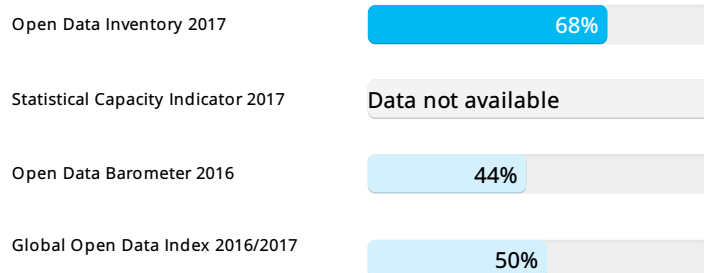
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

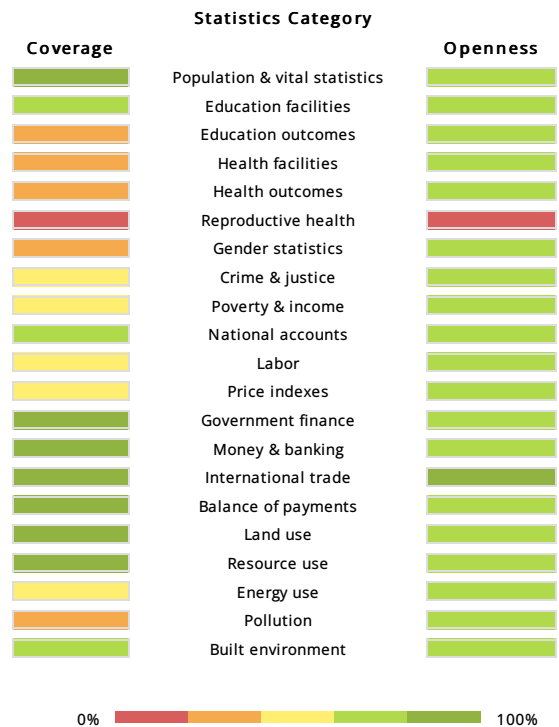
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more economic and environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
