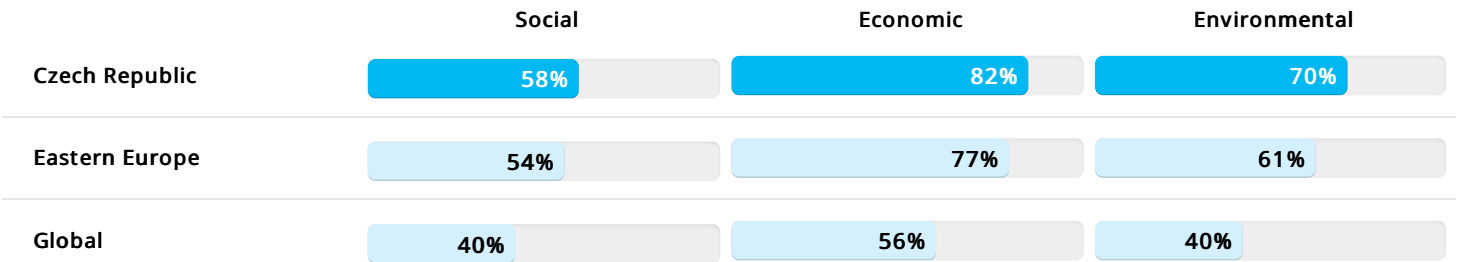

## SUMMARY

Czech Republic ranks 20 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 70%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 69% and a data openness subscore of 70%.

Czech Republic scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

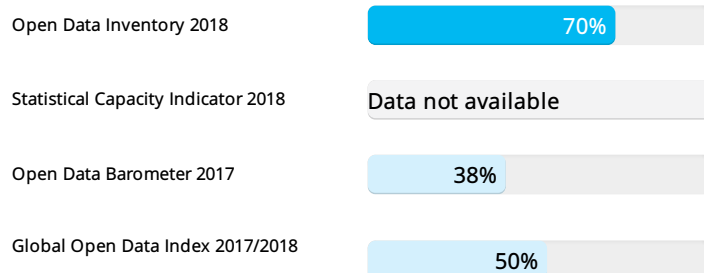
### Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

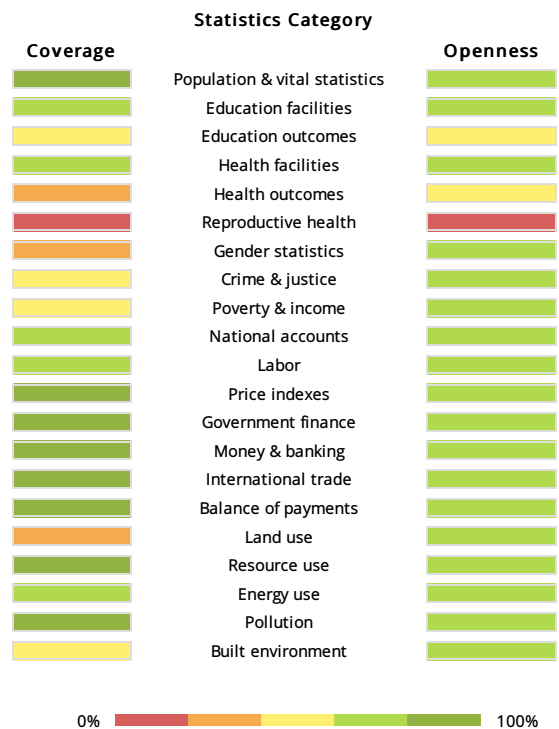
### Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic and environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
