SUMMARY

Germany ranks 25 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 61%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 48% and a data openness subscore of 73%.

Germany scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
