SUMMARY

Germany ranks 7 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 79%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 67% and a data openness subscore of 89%.

Germany scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.
