SUMMARY

France ranks 32 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 58%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 47% and a data openness subscore of 68%.

France scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in social and environmental statistics.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
