SUMMARY

France ranks 31 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 64%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 55% and a data openness subscore of 72%.

France scores higher than the regional median for social statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Make available download options for all data to allow users to customize data exports.
