SUMMARY

United Kingdom ranks 46 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 52%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 49% and a data openness subscore of 55%.

United Kingdom scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

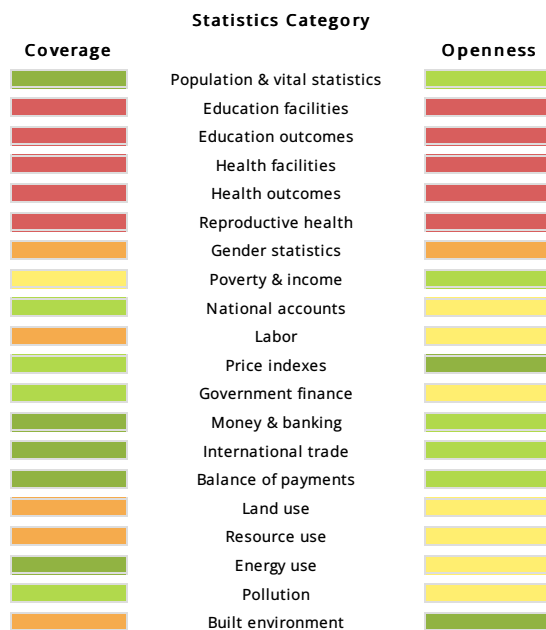
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics for all countries on the NSO website, partly by integrating data from other official sources.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first and second administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

- Make available download options for all data to allow users to customize data exports.
