SUMMARY

The Gambia ranks 166 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 16%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 16% and a data openness subscore of 15%.

The Gambia scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

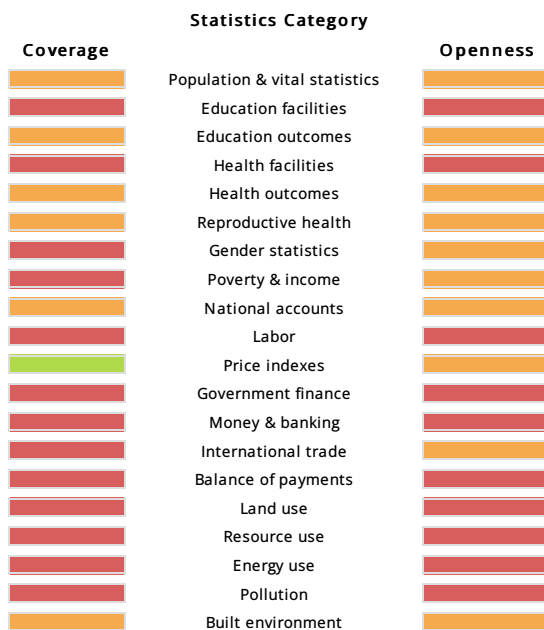
Coverage

- Ensure existing data portals containing official national statistics are made available on the NSO website and maintained.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic and environmental data in machine readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV or JSON.
