SUMMARY

Greece ranks 59 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 48%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 41% and a data openness subscore of 55%.

Greece scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

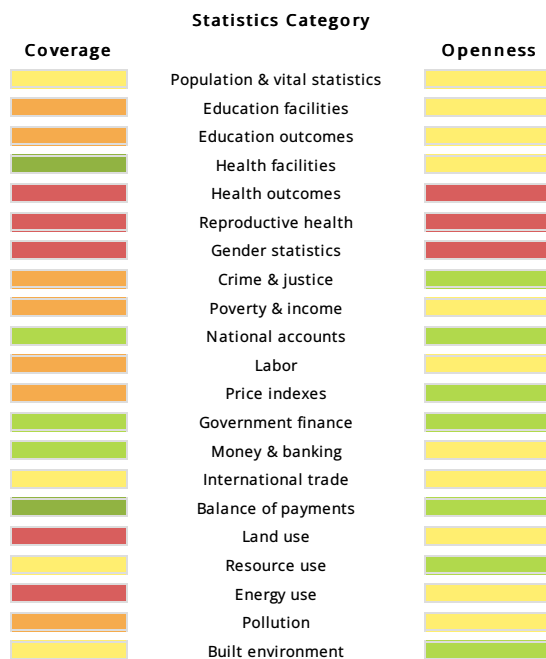
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

Openness

- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
