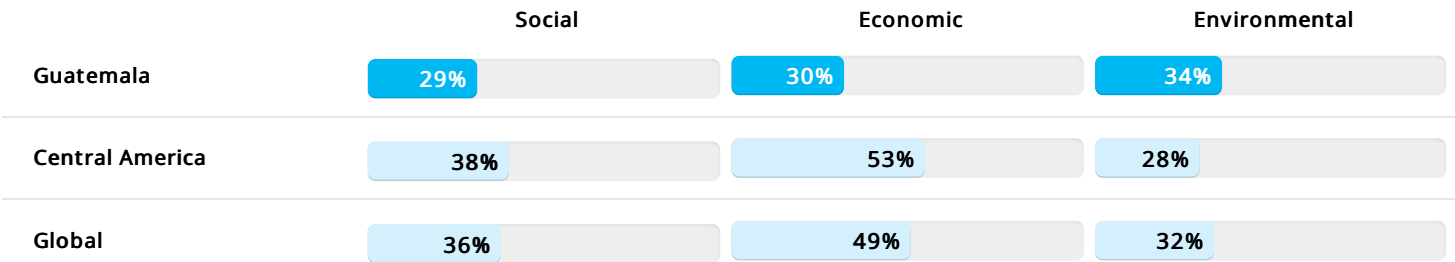

SUMMARY

Guatemala ranks 127 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 31%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 30% and a data openness subscore of 32%.

Guatemala scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

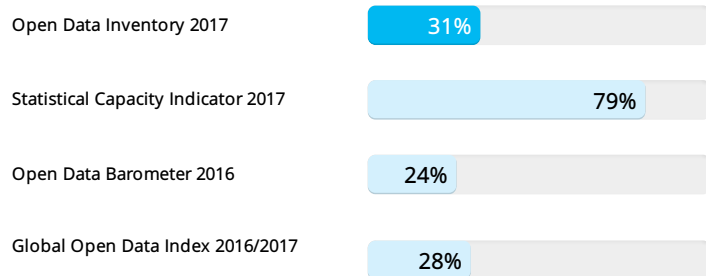
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

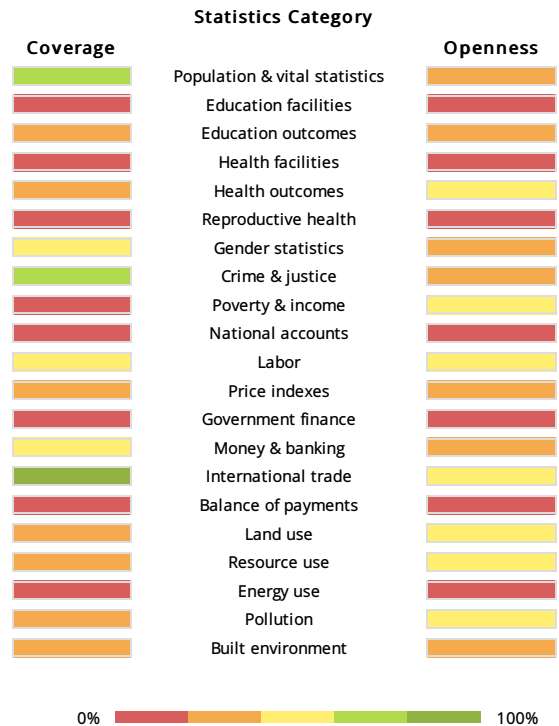
Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more social and economic data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
