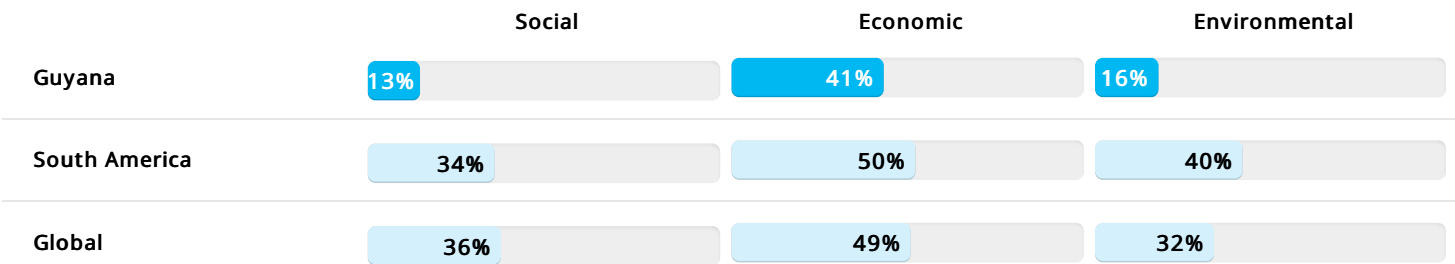

SUMMARY

Guyana ranks 159 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 23%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 23% and a data openness subscore of 22%.

Guyana scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

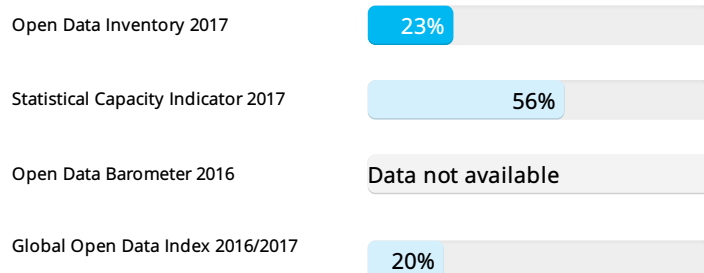
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

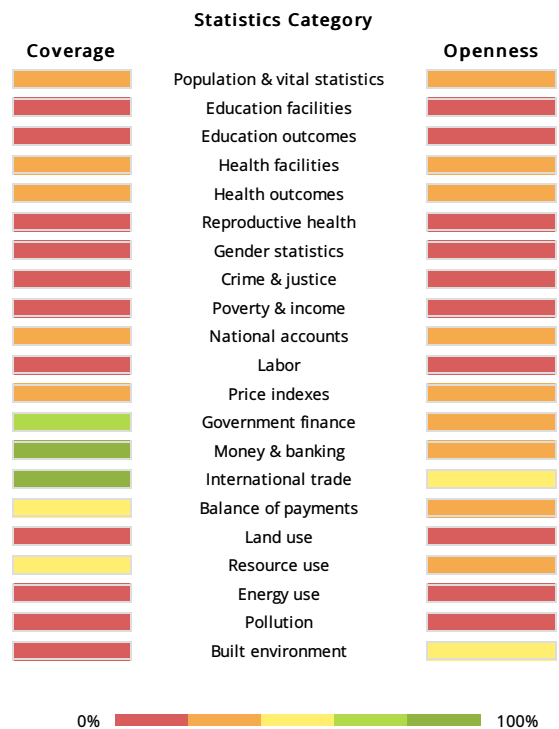
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a noncommercial provision, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
