SUMMARY

Indonesia ranks 84 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 39%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 50% and a data openness subscore of 31%.

Indonesia scores higher than the regional median for economic and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.


Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.


Openness
