SUMMARY

Indonesia ranks 27 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 60%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 61% and a data openness subscore of 59%.

Indonesia scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

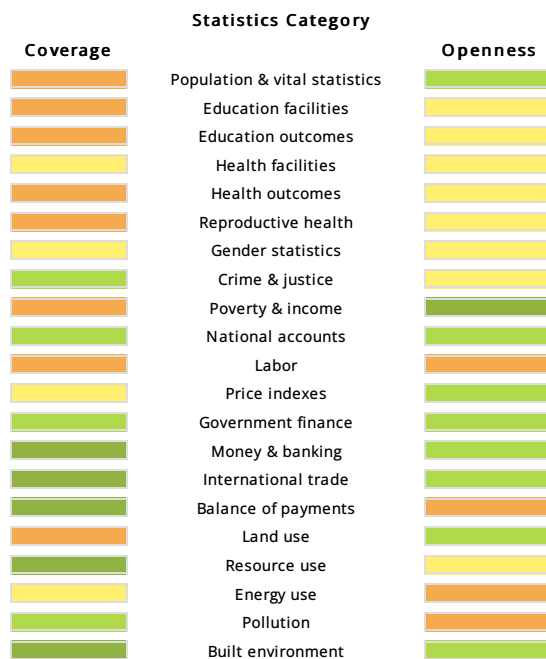
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in social statistics.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a noncommercial provision, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
