SUMMARY

India ranks 37 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 55%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 53% and a data openness subscore of 57%.

India scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

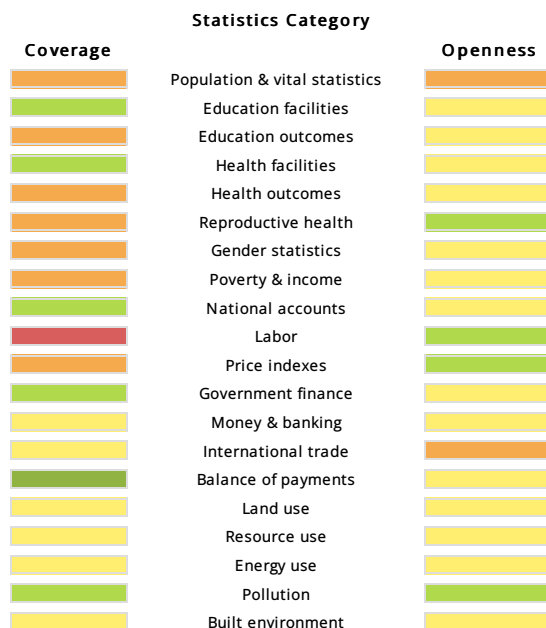
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in social and environmental statistics.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more social and environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
