SUMMARY

Ireland ranks 26 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 61%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 47% and a data openness subscore of 74%.

Ireland scores higher than the regional median for economic statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
