SUMMARY

Iceland ranks 34 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 57%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 45% and a data openness subscore of 68%.

Iceland scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
