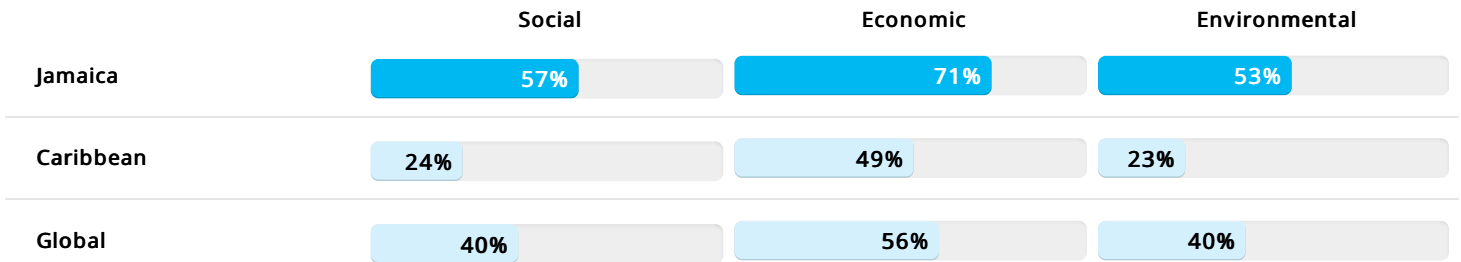

## SUMMARY

Jamaica ranks 37 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 60%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 47% and a data openness subscore of 71%.

Jamaica scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

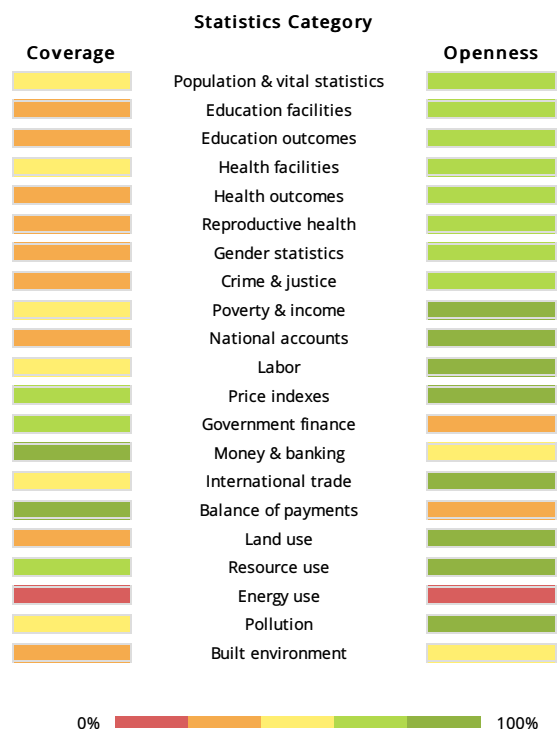
### Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in social and environmental statistics.

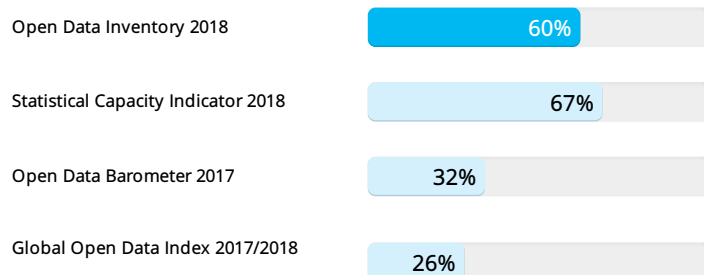
### Openness

- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more social and environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
