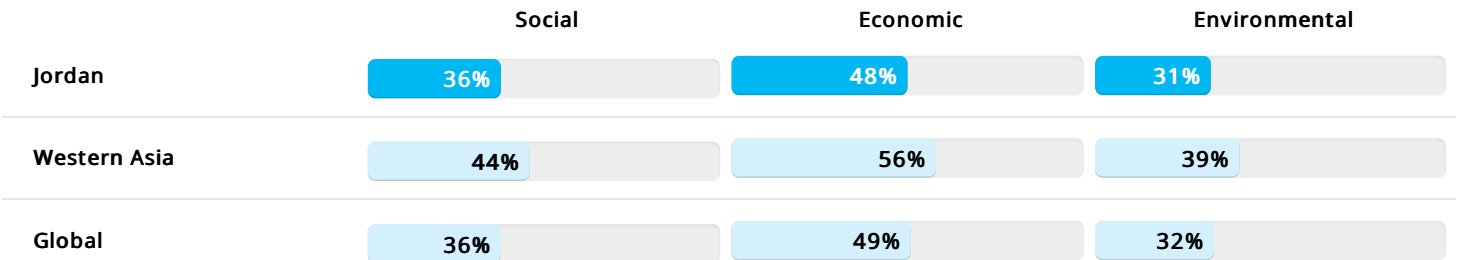

## SUMMARY

Jordan ranks 87 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 38%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 37% and a data openness subscore of 39%.

Jordan scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

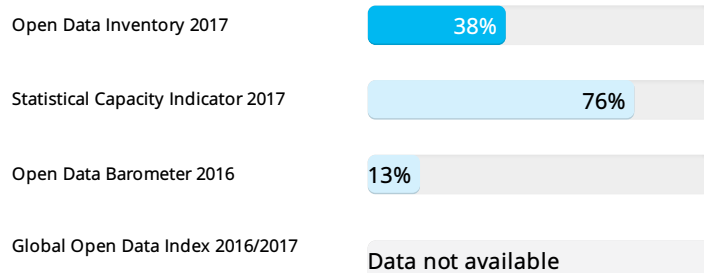
### Coverage Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

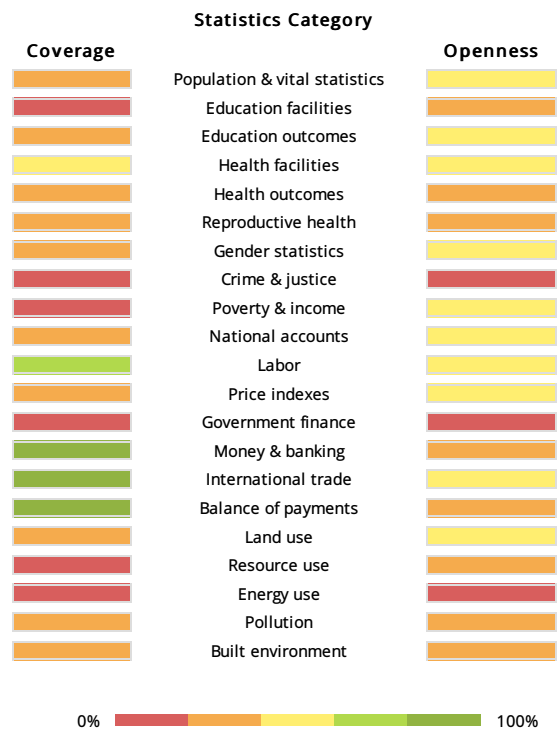
### Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
