### **SUMMARY**

Japan ranks 42 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 54%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 49% and a data openness subscore of 58%.

Japan scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**


# Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data across all data categories.

#### **Openness**

- Publish more data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or ISON.
- Make available download options for all data to allow users to customize data exports.
