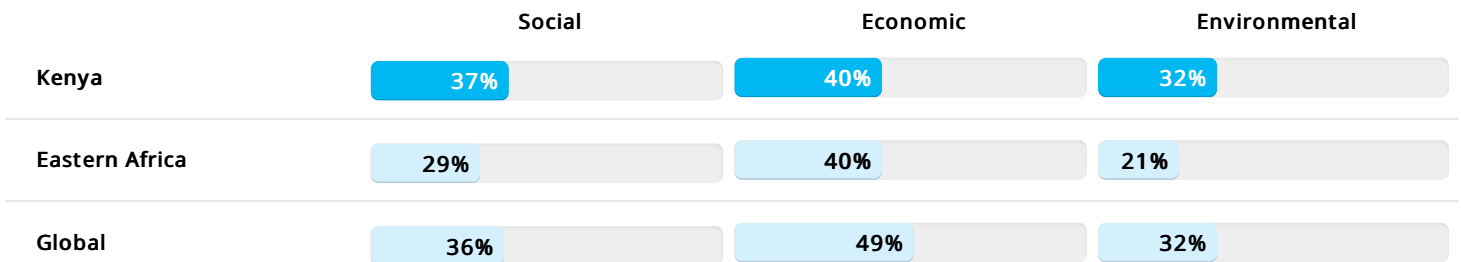

SUMMARY

Kenya ranks 98 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 36%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 41% and a data openness subscore of 32%.

Kenya scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

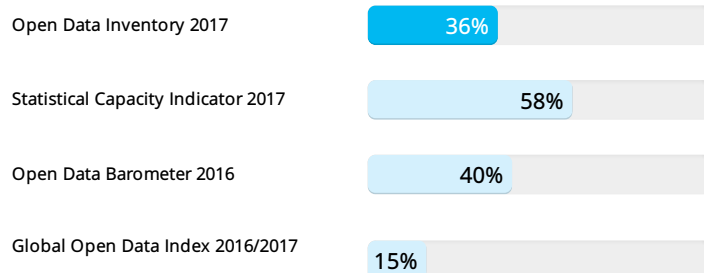
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

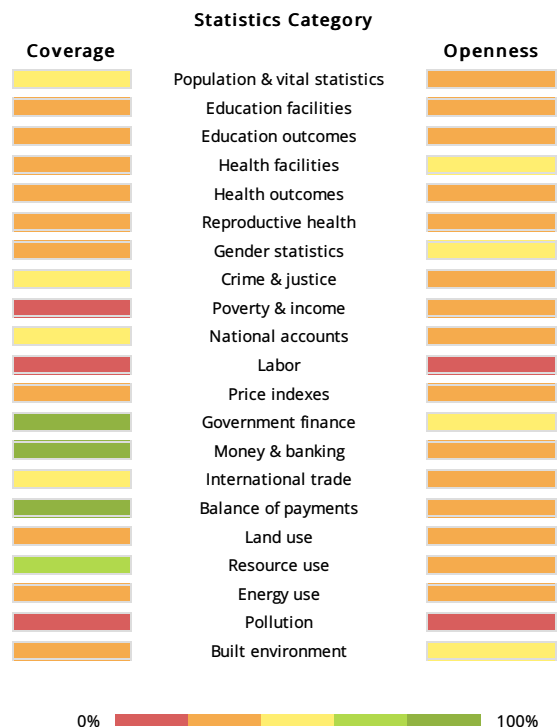
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a noncommercial provision, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
