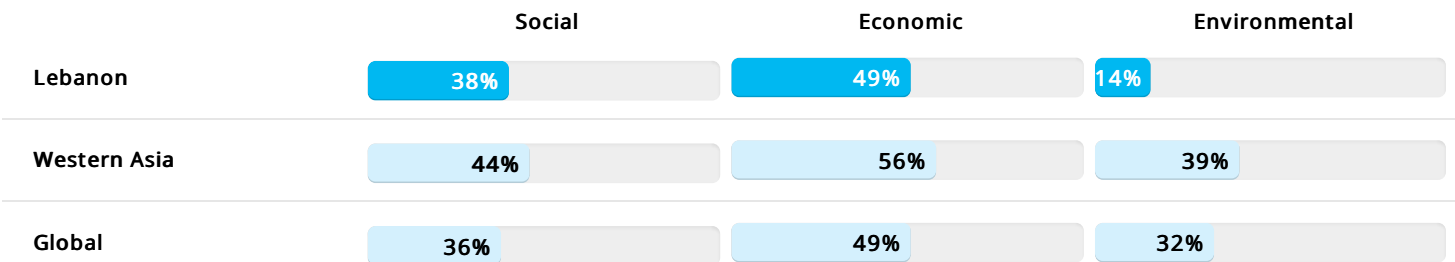

## SUMMARY

Lebanon ranks 120 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 33%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 31% and a data openness subscore of 35%.

Lebanon scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

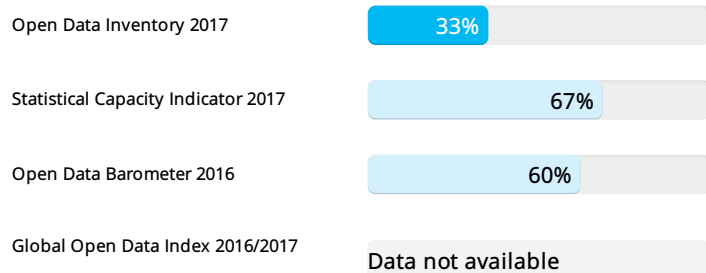
### Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

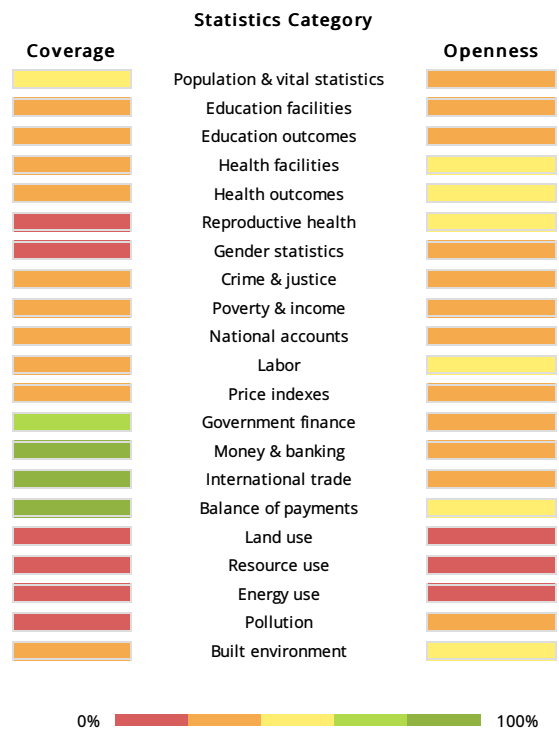
### Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
