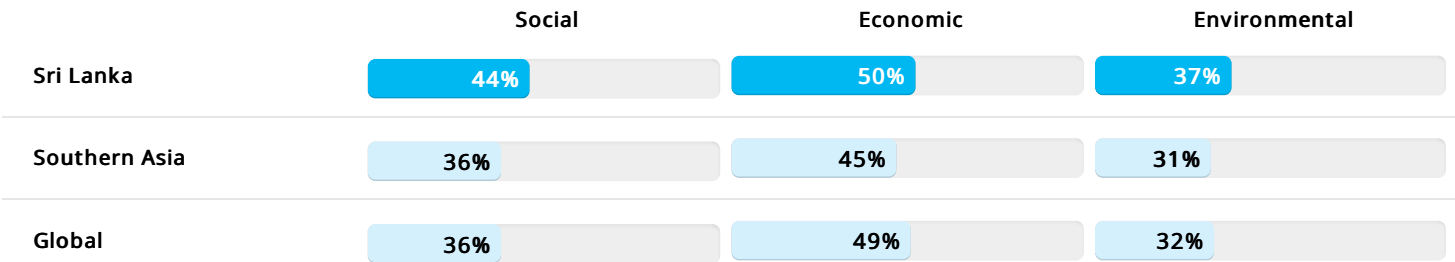

SUMMARY

Sri Lanka ranks 68 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 44%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 46% and a data openness subscore of 42%.

Sri Lanka scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

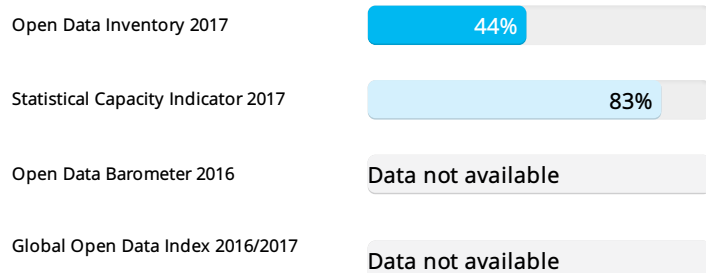
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in social and environmental statistics.

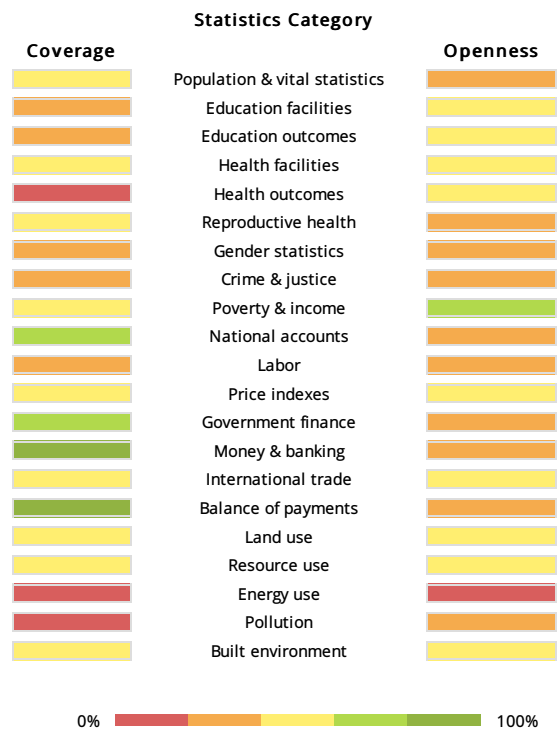
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use policy that does not require prior permission for data use.
- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
