SUMMARY

Marshall Islands ranks 155 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 23%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 21% and a data openness subscore of 25%.

Marshall Islands scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

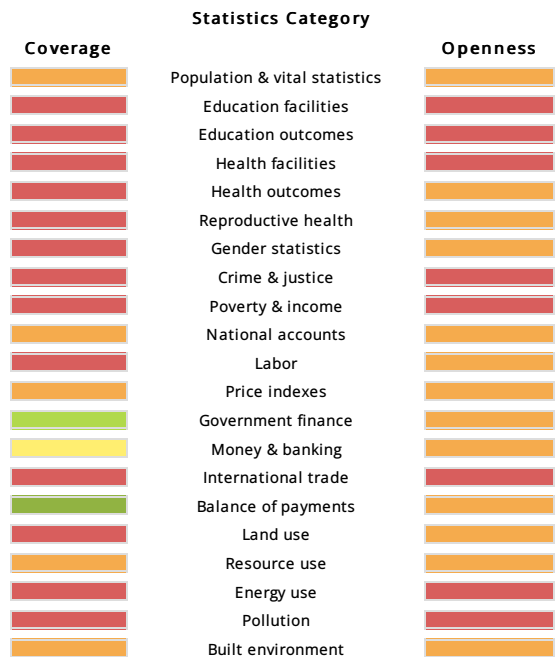
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use policy that does not require prior permission for data use.
- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
