SUMMARY

Montenegro ranks 90 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 38%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 40% and a data openness subscore of 36%.

Montenegro scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

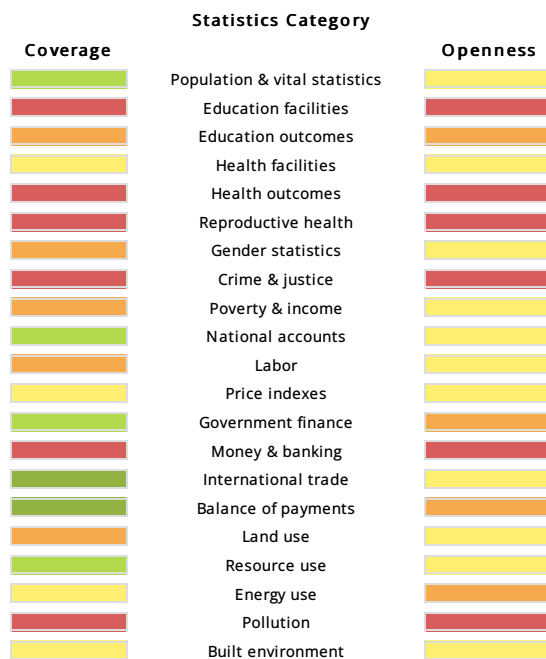
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
