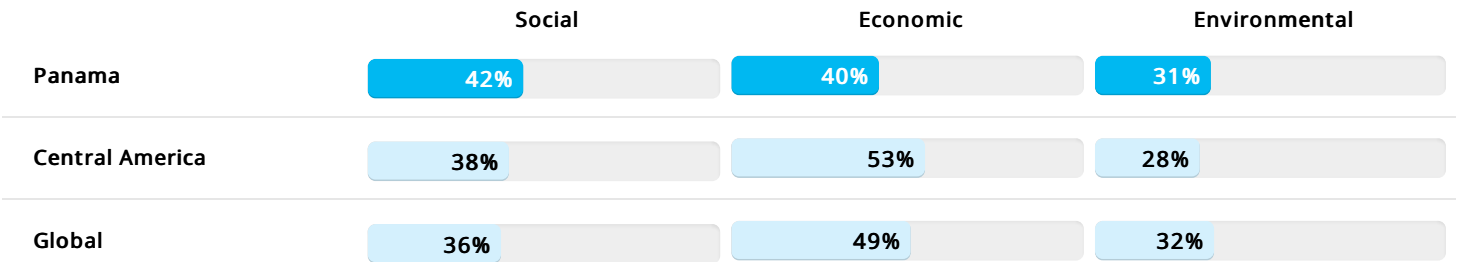

SUMMARY

Panama ranks 92 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 37%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 38% and a data openness subscore of 36%.

Panama scores higher than the regional median for social and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

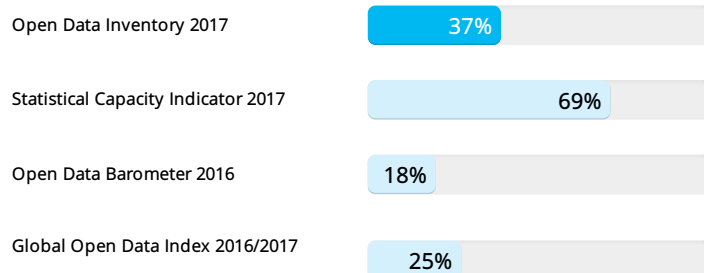
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in economic and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in economic and environmental statistics.

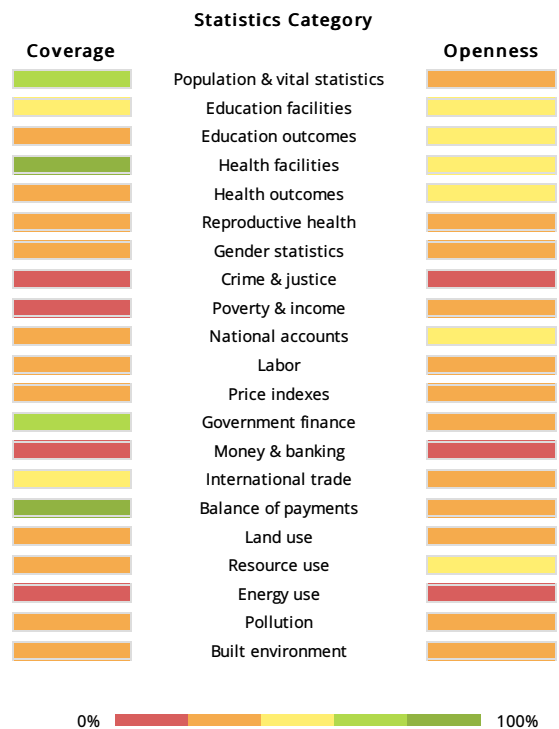
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
