SUMMARY

Philippines ranks 28 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 59%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 46% and a data openness subscore of 70%.

Philippines scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not require an onerous attribution, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more economic and environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.

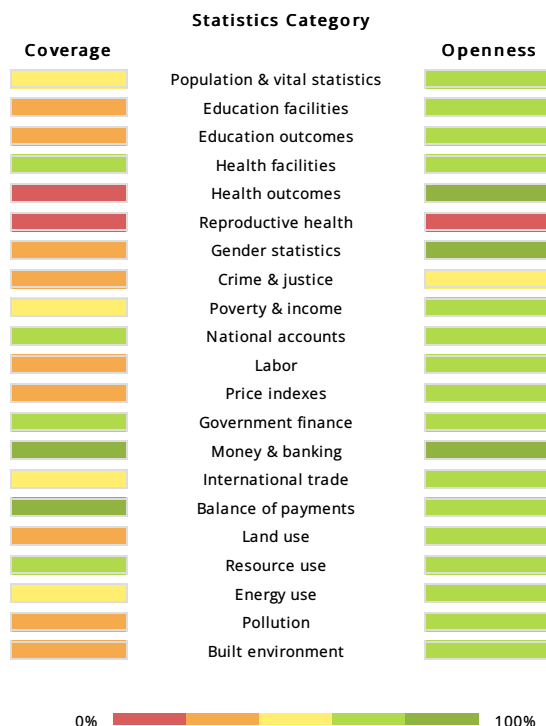
