SUMMARY

Papua New Guinea ranks 167 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 14%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 17% and a data openness subscore of 12%.

Papua New Guinea scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

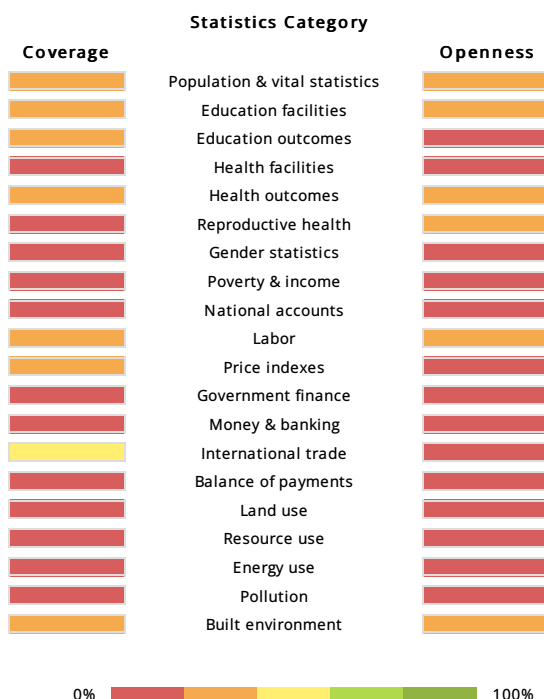
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
