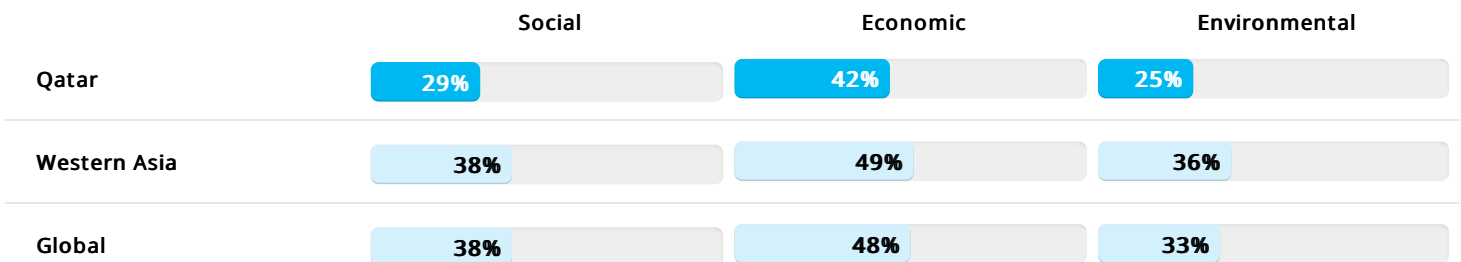

SUMMARY

Qatar ranks 119 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 32%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 36% and a data openness subscore of 28%.

Qatar scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

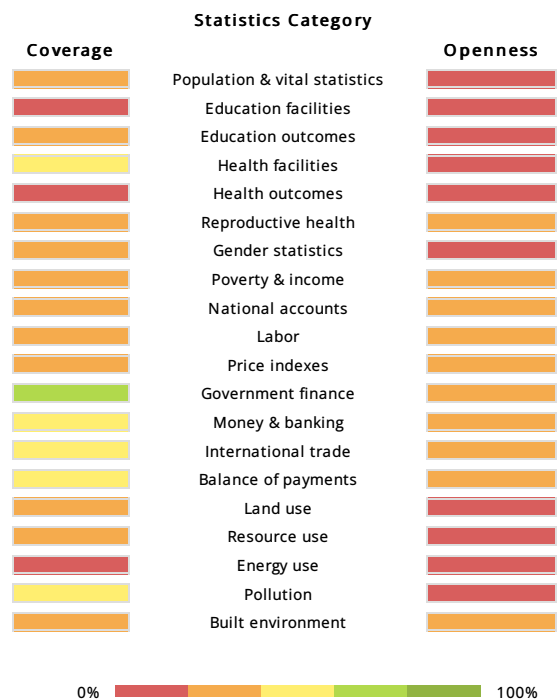
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

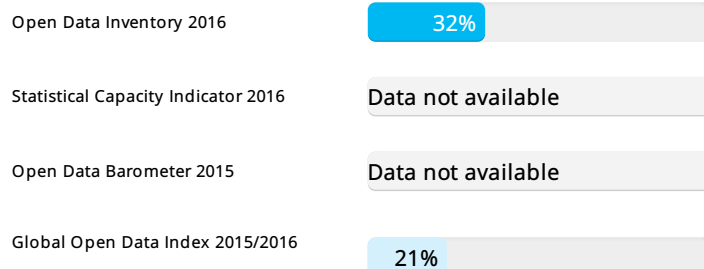
Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
