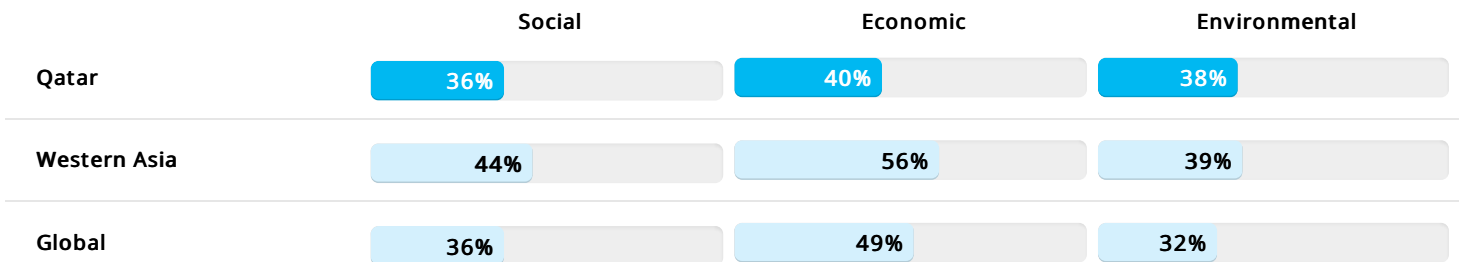

## SUMMARY

Qatar ranks 88 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 38%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 40% and a data openness subscore of 36%.

Qatar scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

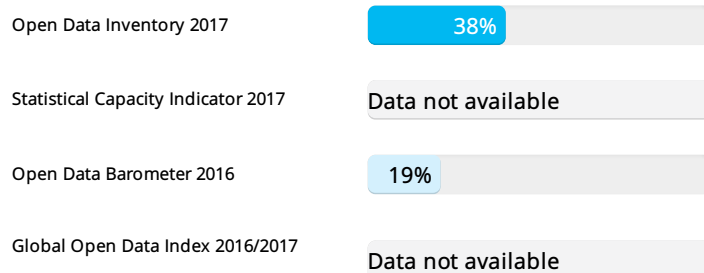
### Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

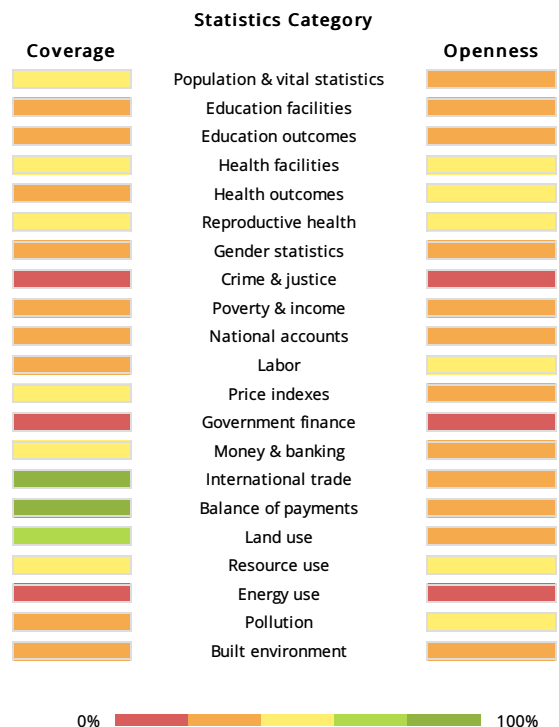
### Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use policy that does not require prior permission for data use.
- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
