

SUMMARY

Romania ranks 45 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 53%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 60% and a data openness subscore of 47%.

Romania scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
