

SUMMARY

Romania ranks 106 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 35%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 35% and a data openness subscore of 36%.

Romania scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.


Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics. Remove registration requirement to access data in portal.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
