

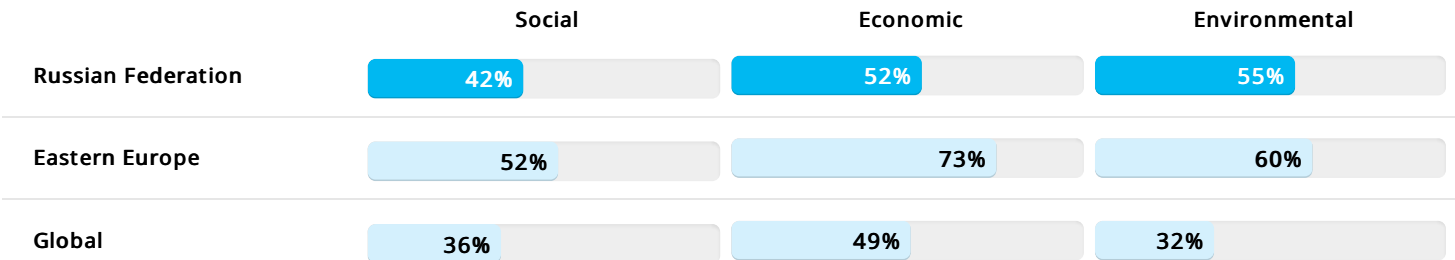

### SUMMARY

Russian Federation ranks 55 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 50%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 57% and a data openness subscore of 43%.

Russian Federation scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

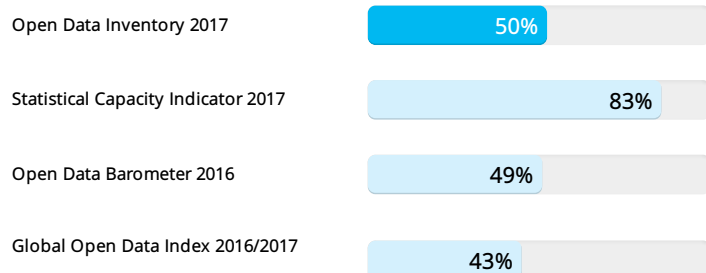
#### Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

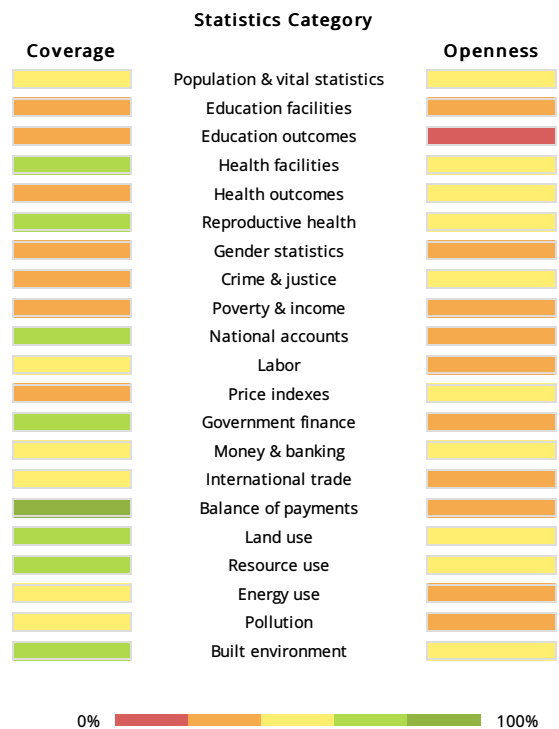
#### Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use that does not have a misleading clause, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more social data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
